Thank you for your interest in becoming a vendor partner at the 2025 Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix. With tens of thousands of spectators, it is the ultimate Western PA event to showcase your products and services. Founded in 1983, the PVGP has grown to become the country's largest vintage race event and the only one run on city streets. Our Schenley Park Race Weekend will be July 19-20.



Each Vendor Village spot now includes a PVGP supplied hi-peak white tent with a back wall. Three sizes of tents (10' x 10', 15' x 15' and 16' x 24') are available. This greatly improves appearance and set-up while increasing traffic flow through the entire area. Tables, chairs, tent sidewalls and electricity are available for rent and will be in your tent when you arrive on Friday.

A tent back wall is included with an area behind your tent to park your support vehicle. If you have a vehicle longer than 15 feet or second vehicle you will not be able to park it behind your tent.

Our PVGP Historics at Pittsburgh International Race Complex in Beaver County provides a Vendor Village during the July 12-13 weekend. Spaces are only \$400 with over 7,500 spectators are expected. Our popular Car Cruise at the Waterfront in Homestead on Tuesday, July 15 draws a large crowd that's already in a shopping mood. Spots are \$250 each. These last two venues do not include tents, electrical power, or offer quantity discounts.

You must be moved out by 7:00 PM Sunday. Sales begin at 9 AM and close at 5:00 PM. This village is on a golf course so your display can not have RVs, heavy equipment, or building materials. Please call to discuss if your display involves more than a tent, table, and chairs.
