

International Jaguar Festival Concours d'Elegance

The 2026 International Jaguar Festival (IJF) will be part of the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix (PVGP). The Concours d'Elegance will take place on the Bob O'Connor Golf Course on July 18th. Trophies will be awarded for the top three highest scoring Jaguars in each class of the Champion, Driven, and Special divisions. The Concours will be held in accordance with the current JCNA rules.

The PVGP has been held annually since 1983 and features the only vintage races in the United States run on public streets. Time trials are run on Saturday with the races on Sunday. The PVGP is a 10-day celebration with many car related events.

What to expect: The members of the Jaguar Club of Pittsburgh will be your host not only to the Concours, but events that may be of particular interest to our guests. The following three events will have the races' Grand Marshall, Ian Callum, as our special guest:

- Thursday – Grand Prix Garden Party held at the Phipps Conservatory
- Friday – Dinner held at the Pittsburgh Golf Club
- Saturday – Concours d'Elegance with Mr. Callum presenting the awards

If you want to participate in the week's events, but you would just rather be part of the IJF "Display" of Jaguars, you should register under the "Marque of the Year". All payments for the events will be handled by the PVGP by way of their website. 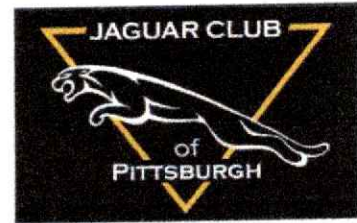
Registrations will be accepted up until June 30th, or before if/when:

- Class Closure – Registration for a class when the number of Jaguars entered reaches the point that assigned judges of the class cannot complete their scoring in the time allotted by JCNA rules.
- Show Closure – Where/when the number of entrants submitted to the Chief Judge reaches the capacity of the show field.
- Confirmation of Receipt – After you have paid your registration fee online and sent your application either by email or US mail, a confirmation email will be sent to you by D. Brian Williams confirming receipt of your application.

JCNA Trophies: A special JCNA/IGF trophy will be presented on the field after the scoring has been completed. We are planning to have Grand Marshall, Ian Callum, to personally present the trophies. This will be a photo opportunity for a special keepsake of the show.

Trailer Parking Assessment

Thank You for enrolling in the International Jaguar Festival component of July's Pittsburgh Grand Prix Motorsports Festival.

The event will bring many Jaguars to Pittsburgh during the IJF from July 16-18, 2026. Many of the travelers will be based at the host hotel, the DoubleTree Pittsburgh-Cranberry Hotel. Most of those participants will drive their Jaguars. We know various cars entered in the Saturday Concours d' Elegance will be trailered to the event; we are assuming cars for the Saturday IJF Marque of the Year Display will be driven to the site but it is possible a few will find the need to transport them in trailers (including those bringing Jaguar Race Cars for Display). The Concours and the Marque of the Year Display jaguars, on Saturday, July 18, will be embedded into the middle of the PVGP International Car Show on the Bob O'Connor Golf Course at Schenley Park, where there will be thousands of vehicles. And it is possible cars may need to be trailered to the Slalom site at the Manheim Pittsburgh Auto Auction. The Jaguar Club of Pittsburgh wants to ensure that participants in these IJF-sponsored events are provided with adequate provisions for vehicle trailers, provided any trailer is registered with the IJF by June 30, 2026.

To properly plan for these events, understanding participant expectations for unloading, loading, and parking those trailers requires collecting information on those requirements and expectations. Accordingly, we are requesting your support in responding to the attached questionnaire.

Please complete the attached Trailer Information Form and return it with your other Registration documents to the Concours, Display, and Slalom Chairs pursuant to the instructions on the registration forms on the Vivenu web site for PVGP, which the IJF is utilizing for IJF registration and payment for all events. You need to pay and "Pre-register" for events using the Vivenu web site, which is <https://vivenu.com/event/2026-jaguar-marque-of-the-year-ijf-trwvpv8>. Once you pay and provide information on the Vivenu payment site, you need to download the registration forms and complete hard copies (there is no ability to complete and submit them on line from the Vivenu website) and send them via email or the USPS to the relevant event chairs and the Trailer Questionnaire is part of some packets. Once the event chair receives your registration documents, they will email you a confirmation of registration and at that time you will be considered as fully registered for that event. If you have previously paid and pre-registered on Vivenu before April 4, the Event Chair will be emailing you this Trailer Questionnaire, and we are asking that you return it within a week of receipt via email or the USPS to that chairperson.

Each Concours, Display, and Slalom event needs a separate registration packet sent to each event chair, including the completed Trailer Questionnaire even if that last submission seems duplicative.

The IJF Committee is also using the Trailer Questionnaire to also advise the DoubleTree Pittsburgh-Cranberry Hotel of your intent to park there so security arrangements can be appropriately made by the hotel.

If you are bringing a trailer and have properly completed and returned this form, you will receive advance confirmation of the specific trailer parking plan and pass that applies to you.

If you are planning to bring a trailer and do not complete and return the form and receive confirmation, please do not plan on being able to park a trailer at any of the IJF events. There is no additional cost being charged by the IJF for Trailer Parking but due to limitations, any trailer needs to be registered with the Trailer Committee so the IJF can ensure there is space for it at the Concours and Display on July 18 and the Slalom on July 17.

Worst case, it may be necessary to unload your car near the show field, then move your tow rig up to 1.5 mile to a designated trailer parking area. If so, a shuttle service will be available to bring drivers back to the show area where you will then take your car onto the field. The Committee will get reserved trailer parking as close to the show field as possible. It is recommended you arrive as early as possible with your trailer after 6:30 AM on Saturday, July 18, but at the latest you need to be there by 7:30 AM.
